Tuition and Fees

Enrollment Fee (Non-refundable): \$50

- If paid per semester: \$6,250 (\$3,125 due by August 1st, '25; \$3,125 due by January 1, '26)
- If paid monthly: \$6,400 (\$640 per month, due by the 1st of each month: Aug 1st - May 1st)
- Sibling discounts:
 - 1st student: standard tuition rates apply
 - 2nd student: 3% discount (range for 2nd student = \$5,917 to \$6,208)
 - 3rd student: 5% discount (range for 3rd student = \$5,795 to \$6,080)

Tuition Grant Opportunity (Need-based)

- Eligible families may apply for a tuition grant. Eligibility for the grant is based on eligibility for the WI school voucher program. Income requirements can be found on page three in the "WPCP" column [here](#) (WI DPI Private School Choice Programs document). Request an application for this tuition grant from PHCS. Applications are due June 15, 2025, and priority is based on need and order in which applications are received. There are two available per school year.
- The grant is worth \$3,000 (deducted off yearly tuition), regardless of other applicable discounts.
 - Note: some churches provide scholarships to members who want to attend a local Christian school. Ask your church about this. If they are able to provide a scholarship for your family, it will provide another family with an opportunity to receive the PHCS tuition grant.

Tuition Fundraising Opportunity (AKA "Scrip")

- RaiseRight App: 50% goes to PHCS, 50% goes to your students' tuition for the following year OR gets reimbursed directly to you at the end of the school year.

Tuition will be invoiced per semester. Families will decide before each semester how they will be paying: full year, per semester, or 10 monthly payments (beginning Aug. 1st).

Financial Disclosures

- To preserve academic and spiritual freedom from government regulations, PHCS does not accept government funding or subsidies at any level: federal, state, or district. As such, all school expenses are paid through tuition, fundraising, and donations. (This includes expenses for materials and curriculum as well as staff salaries, payroll taxes and fees, school insurance, rent, snow plowing, teaching assistants, lab materials, guest speakers, school-sponsored events, some field trips, accounting fees, legal fees, and office supplies.)
- Private school tuition is tax deductible: \$4,000 for primary/middle and \$10,000 for high school.
- PHCS's FEIN # is 99-3708786. Our WI DPI school code is 1804.
- PHCS converted to a nonprofit, 501c3 corporation in June 2024. As of January 2025, we are waiting to receive our official tax-exempt status number from the IRS, so we are still paying taxes on all school expenses and curriculum.

Signatures Required

I understand that the PowerHouse school year budget is based on the number of students that are accepted. PHCS is completely committed to each student and assumes that accepted students and their parents are committed as well. Therefore, if a student withdraws from PHCS, full payment of tuition regardless of attendance is required. (Exceptions may apply on rare occasions and are determined by the school board.)
